Remembering God's words will help you be PREPARED. They remind you to love others, serve others, and forgive others. In short, remembering God's words means doing things God's way.

Ask a parent or grandparent to tell you about a time when it was hard to forgive someone, but he or she made the wise choice and did so anyway.
